

What it costs

WHOS is funded by the State Health Department for expenditure such as staff direct services, however this does not cover all operating costs. To cover costs such as food and provisions, accommodation, travel to and from meetings/appointments and activities, laundry, medical supplies/prescriptions, official communications and postage, stress management classes, movies, videos, leisure activities and other community functions it is necessary to charge a fee or ask for a significant proportion of your benefit entitlement for your first three months. After three months your focus is on leaving the community and you will only need to contribute for food and accommodation. A savings plan is available ensuring some financial security when leaving our program.

WHOS Mission Statement

The overall framework from which our objectives are derived are: to foster personal growth within a drug free therapeutic program. This is complemented by incorporating the concepts of harm minimisation from substance misuse/abuse, including the spread of communicable diseases for example HIV/HCV.
